



Uniform Policy 2023-2024

Required for Kindergarten – 8th Grade

Northside bases its policy upon Biblical Standards of modesty (I Timothy 2:9-10; Romans 12:1-2; I Peter 3:3-4; Colossians 3:17; I Corinthians 10:31) and the desire for a respectful, non-distracting educational atmosphere where God is glorified and where students respect themselves and care enough not to cause another student to stumble. NCS recognizes the important impact of student dress on the learning environment. We understand that all of our lives, including dress, bring honor or dishonor to our God. We also embrace our identity as a Christian school and how we dress impacts our witness for Christ to the world. We see the uniforms not as a means to achieve or gain righteousness before God but as an opportunity to demonstrate how one's love for God, self, and others is lived out in a practical way. Our desire is to work hand in hand with students and families to help nurture and develop a heart of honoring God.

TOP CHOICES

- **Color Palette: blue, gray, black, or white**
- Short/long sleeve polo shirt
- Button down collared shirt
- Pullover sweater: crew or V-neck

PANTS / SHORT CHOICES

- **Durable trousers / shorts: khaki, tan, gray, dark blue, black**
- Pockets: back split & front flat
